Thank you for your request for information below, which we received on 20 July 2026. Please find our response below in bold:

The Council has determined that the information you are requesting is environmental information, under the definition contained within Regulation 2(1) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004. The Council has therefore processed your request under the terms of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004.

I would like to request a current, complete list of all camera-enforced bus lane and bus gate locations operated by the council, and for each location: the road/junction name, the hours of operation, the vehicles permitted to use it, and (if held) the date enforcement began.

The information you have requested is exempt from disclosure under Section 21 of the FOIA as it is reasonably accessible by another means. This is an absolute exemption and no Public Interest Test is necessary.
